Other Details: From wedding coordinator at Royal Melbourne:

"In the wedding garden, the only shade or cover would be under the building. Unfortunately, they are not going to be able to see what is going on if that is where they are positioned. I can show you during the tasting, where that would be. Most of our musicians set up in the back of the wedding garden, but there isn't shade or cover there. To that point, they are typically on grass so it isn't going to be perfectly level. We have had many DJs and musicians play in the garden and it's never been an issue. Depending on where they set up, we are drawing power from the building. If we provide a longer extension cord, would that work for them?"
