Let You Go (ILLENIUM) (Recorded) (Bride and groom will walk back up the aisle after the bridal party has also receded to release rows one by one. Please let each song continue in entirety before playing the next.)

Take Your Time (Last Heroes) (Recorded) (Next in line after the first two.)

After these three songs, transition into live, dueling pianos for cocktail hour while guests will be beginning to flood into (These two spaces are connected and you will be set up in between.)
