Ceremony Setup

Setup: for the ceremony we requested just 1 piano to play instrumentals so guests can be seated and then recorded music for the aisle marches. This will be setup outside on the grass. Inside setup for the full show/reception will be on a wood floor near the back of the reception space. the event coordinators will show the musicians where to be.

Sound System Needs

The officiant (Jamey Edwards) will require a handheld microphone with stand. Jamey Edwards is expected to arrive around 03:30 pm. **Important:** Remember to find out what the officiant's last words will be before the recessional music begins! No readers will need a microphone. You will be providing live music so have a keyboard set up.
