Performance Expectations - 3 - A mix of interaction with both traditional requests and dance songs.

This number represents a sliding scale between 0 and 5. 0 leans towards traditional bar show with lots of dueling piano banter and comedy. 5 represents a wedding show with little talking and non-stop dancing.

Departure And Load-Out

After-Party - Announce the following details:

There will be a bonfire to wrap up the evening. Most people will know this as we have people camping at the venue with us all weekend. You can give a small reminder that the party will continue outside the venue (weather permitting). It's one giant camping area. campers are arriving on Friday.

You don't need to go home, but we do (MTV cribs joke or reference?)

We must be packed up and out of the venue by 01:00 am

Additional Information: I have one idea if you need to get people out on the dance floor to start the evening...

A call to the dance floor...

Starting with:

Active or retired military personnel/men and women.

2. Active or retired police force

3. Staff with St. Cloud Orthopedics or St. Cloud Surgical Center

4. Social workers, LPN/s, Speech Language Pathologists and Nursing Professors
